

Park City Matron Dies in Columbus

PARK CITY — Funeral services were held Wednesday for Mrs. Dora Jensen, 65, wife of Ole Jensen of Park City, who died in a Columbus hospital Saturday night. Mrs. Jensen had undergone surgery last Tuesday.

She was born in Dunbar, Neb., July 17, 1893, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Wilson. She taught school for seven years in western Nebraska and was active in church work. She was married to Mr. Jensen July 9, 1919, in Kearney, Neb., and in July 1930 they moved to Montana where they ranched on Valley Creek for three years before moving to Park City.

Mrs. Jensen is survived by her husband, two daughters, Mrs. Floyd Rader of Seattle and Mrs. William Bistock of Mammoth; a son, Delbert of Littleton, Colo., two sisters, Mrs. Alta Lindholm of Oconto, Neb., and Mrs. Jenny Osburn of Wichita, Kan.; two brothers, John Wilson of Oconto and Thomas Wilson of Wichita and five grandchildren.
