

MRS. JANE WILSON ANSWERS LAST ROLL CALL -- WAS PIONEER RESIDENT

Mrs. Jane Dunbar Wilson, one of the pioneer residents of Dunbar, died at her home in Delaware precinct Wednesday night of last week. The deceased was born in County Antrim, Ireland, in 1815. She came to America in 1829, residing in Canada for a number of years. She came to Dunbar in 1856 and has since resided there.

She was married to Thomas Wilson on Christmas day 1833, and to this union were born eight children, five of whom survive her. There are also 53 grand children, 105 great-grand-children and 4 great-great-grand-children. The deceased was a daughter of Thomas Dunbar for whom the village was named. The first postoffice was located in the old Wilson home as was also the freight and stage station.

The funeral was held Friday at 10 o'clock from the United Brethern church in Dunbar, the Rev. J. S. Tussey officiating. Interment was made in Wyuka cemetery.—Press.
