

Logan Powell, 64, Scottsbluff, dies

Logan Gates Powell, 64, Scottsbluff, died in Lincoln Sunday night from complications which arose from influenza. He was a resident of Johnson county practically all of his life.

The son of Louise and the late John P. Powell of Crab Orchard, Neb., he was born in Rockyford, Colo., Aug. 20, 1879. He was married Oct. 26, 1913 to Laura Ethel Ervin, Arnold, Neb.

They established their home on a farm one and a half miles north of Crab Orchard and moved last fall to Scottsbluff, where Mr. Powell was engaged in construction work.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a. m. Tuesday in the Methodist church at Crab Orchard. Burial in Crab Orchard cemetery.
