## FIRST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH RECORDS, ROCHESTER, N. H.

---

[Rochester was incorporated as a town, May 10, 1722. The present towns of Farmington and Milton were formerly a part of Rochester. Farmington was set off and incorporated December 1, 1798, and Milton was set off and incorporated June 11, 1802. A part of the farm of Rufus C. Varney was severed and annexed to Barrington, July 10, 1846. Rochester was incorporated as a city, March 31, 1891. It is commonly said that Capt. Timothy Roberts, formerly of Dover, was the first settler in Rochester, and that he moved into that town, December 26, 1728. We have no confidence, however, in this statement; there are good reasons for believing that settlements were made in what is now Rochester at least sixty-five years before the town was incorporated. Rev. Amos Main was the first settled minister, he became pastor of the church at Rochester in 1737.]

77. NOWELL.—For some time I have been collecting data regarding the Nowell family, particularly the descendants of Capt. Peter Nowell, of York, Maine and should be pleased to receive information, and to correspond with members of this family. There is not much information available in reference to the later generations, and must be collected from members, of the family, who have records and facts in their possession. Capt. Peter Nowell born 1670, probably in the Isle of Jersey in the English Channel, removed from Salem, Mass. to York, Me. in summer of 1695. He married in 1698, Sarah, daughter of Peter and Mary (Davis) Weare, of York, born January, 1676, died September 13, 1729; married secondly Mary Preble, widow of Abraham Preble, February 19, 1730. He was very prominent in the history of York and died May 10, 1740, leaving a family of six sons and three daughters. Their names were as follows:

9. Silas, born 1719; m. 1st Hannah Came; 2nd Rachel Wallingford, daughter of Judge Thomas Wallingford of Somersworth, N. H.

Descendants of Ebenezer and Silas lived in Berwick, Me., nearly all persons of the name coming from Maine or New Hampshire probably descend from Capt. Peter. There was likely some relationship between Capt. Peter Nowell and Increase Nowell, Secretary of the Massachusetts Bay Colony, who came with Winthrop in 1630, but this has never been established.

The most important published work for New Hampshire genealogists dealing with the 18th century is undoubtedly the present useful yet rather obscure work. This periodical was published quarterly between July of 1903 and April of 1910 in twenty-six issues under the auspices of the New Hampshire Genealogical Society. It contains a wealth of extremely valuable source materials, but until now has been so rare and difficult to find, that it has not been widely known or used. These volumes contain vital records, land grants, lists of town officers, some cemetery inscriptions, several genealogies, tax lists, informative queries and answers, book reviews, obituaries, and more.

As it originally was issued this periodical had a complete, annual, name index in the fourth issue of each volume. Since many of the articles were carried forward from issue to issue and volume to volume this made it necessary to search through six different indexes which was a tedious process. In this new reprint edition we have eliminated all the individual indexes, and have replaced them with a single, master index to the entire set. This index was compiled many years ago by some unknown person, and has been available to researchers at the New Hampshire Historical Society Library, but has not previously been published. It is presented here courtesy of the Library, and will greatly facilitate the use of this valuable resource.
