Harry C. Teets, 69, former Huronian who died about 4:30 O'Clock Sunday morning at his home west of Onida, will be buried in Riverside Cemetery in Huron on Wednesday afternoon.

The funeral services will be held at Onida Tuesday afternoon and the body will be brought to Huron for funeral services at Kinyon's Chapel Wednesday afternoon at 2 O'clock. The Rev Alfred Trenerry will be in charge: The Huron Elks Lodge No. 444 of which he was a member, will have charge of services at Riverside Cemetery.

Relatives surviving Mr. Teets are the widow Alice Teets; one daughter; two sons; ten grandchildren; three sisters. One brother A.F. Teets died at Sioux City.

Mr. Teets was born at Lumbar, Ill., February 28, 1868. He came with his parents, Captain and Mrs. B.F. Teets, to Beadle County in 1883. He was married to Alice Garrison at Carpenter in 1890 and they continued to live in Beadle County until 1919 when they moved to Sully County.
